Jason Bret Largue, MHS, PA-C, MBA, serves as the Director of Assessment and Curricular Advancement in the Physician Assistant Department at the University of South Alabama. He has been a full-time faculty member since May 2019, and during his tenure, he has held key leadership roles within the program, including Director of Didactic Education.

Professor Largue brings significant clinical experience as a physician assistant, with practice experience specializing in hospital medicine and infusion therapies. He worked as a hospitalist at Infirmity Medical Center and later provided targeted patient care at the USA Health COVID Monoclonal Antibody Infusion Clinic. Prior to joining the faculty full-time, he served as an adjunct teacher for the physician assistant program, teaching clinical medicine, diagnostic data, and anatomy.

His academic and teaching interests include clinical medicine, pathophysiology, anatomy, and clinical reasoning. He is deeply involved in hands-on medical training, serving as a Simulation Facilitator at the USA Medical School where he teaches physical exam techniques, procedural skills, and clinical reasoning to medical students and nurse practitioners. His scholarly work includes contributing to a clinical reasoning textbook and presenting research on interprofessional education and collaborative care between physical therapy and physician assistant students. He holds a Master of Health Science in Physician Assistant Studies and a Master of Business Administration, both from the University of South Alabama.

Outside of his professional and academic endeavors, Professor Largue is committed to community service and youth leadership. An Eagle Scout himself, he currently serves as an Assistant Scoutmaster for Scouting America, Troop 147.
